Minutes of the 8th meeting of the Inter-Ministerial Committee dated 11.8.2016 for recognition as Pre-Shipment Inspection Agency

The 8th meeting of the Inter-Ministerial Committee was held on 11.8.2016 at 3.00 p.m. in Room No. 11, H-Wing, Udyog Bhawan under the chairmanship of Shri K.C. Rout, Additional Director General of Foreign Trade to consider the applications for recognition as Pre-Shipment Inspection Agency (PSIA).

- 2. The following members attended the meeting:
- (i) Shri S.P. Roy, Jt. DG, DGFT
- (ii) Shri S.K. Bhatnagar, Deputy Industrial Adviser, Min. of Steel
- (iii) Shri S.K. Jain, Development Officer, Dept. of Industrial Policy & Promotion
- (iv) Shri Ajeet Singh, Scientific Officer C, Atomic Energy Regulatory Board

(the representative from Min. of Environment, Forest & Climate Change did not attend the meeting)

- 3. At the onset of the meeting, AERB representative pointed out that same machines are being shown by more than one applicant. The Committee, accordingly was of the view that integrity of such applicants is under doubt and decided to reject applications of all such applicants in the first instance, where machines with same number figures, though there may still be other deficiencies. The Committee also decided that for applicants who have been approved as PSIA, if it is found that the machine they possess is actually being held by another company, then their case would also be re-considered by the Committee. The Committee further decided to return the Bank Guarantee of all applicants (if their Bank Guarantee is with DGFT) whose cases are rejected in this meeting. The Committee further decided that no fresh application will be accepted by DGFT until further notice.
- 4. The following decisions were taken by the Committee:

1. Cosmos Inspection & Analysis, Haryana

The Committee **rejected** the application of M/s Cosmos Inspection & Analysis, Haryana on the following grounds-

- (i) Information not provided on dose rate of Radcomm Rhandy 100388 100397
- (ii) Radcomm Rhandy 100397 shown by the applicant is also shown by M/s Neerakshan Engineers & Surveyors, Chennai as possessed by them
- (iii) Radcomm Mspec 200189 shown by the applicant is also shown by M/s Techsusho Kayaba Corp., Japan as possessed by them

2. Global Marine Inspection Unit, New Delhi

The Committee **rejected** the application of M/s Global Marine Inspection Unit, New Delhi on the following grounds-

- (i) The calibration certificates submitted by the applicant are not in acceptable format
- (ii) Radcomm Mspec 200190 & 200191 shown by the applicant are also shown by M/s Techsusho Kayaba Corp., Japan as possessed by them

3. Bureau Veritas India Pvt. Ltd., Mumbai

The Committee **rejected** the application of M/s Bureau Veritas India Pvt. Ltd., Mumbai on the following grounds-

- (i) The membership of the applicant of IFIA is for the period 2005 and 2008
- (ii) The applicant has not given declaration regarding qualification of manpower despite communication from this Directorate

4. Ravi Energie Pvt. Ltd., Baroda

The Committee decided to **hold in abeyance** the application of M/s Ravi Energie Pvt. Ltd., Baroda till the investigation / procedure under FTDR Act against them is completed.

5. Transborder Safety Control Inspection Services LLC, USA

The Committee **rejected** the application of M/s Transborder Safety Control Inspection Services LLC, USA because the company has been delisted by DGFT vide P.N. No. 23 dated 22/7/2016.

6. CWM Survey & Inspection, Netherland

The Committee **rejected** the application of M/s CWM Survey & Inspection, Netherland on the following grounds-

- (i) The applicant does not have any spectrometer
- (ii) The validity of calibration certificates have expired

7. Nectar Inspection Services LLC, UAE

The Committee **rejected** the application of M/s Nectar Inspection Services LLC, UAE on the following grounds-

- (i) All calibration results are same which is technically not possible
- (ii) Radcomm Mspec 200085 & 200086 shown by the applicant are also shown by M/s Techsusho Kayaba Corp., Japan as possessed by them

8. Akkrediteret Vejer & Inspection Aarhus A/S Vejebro Aarhus

The Committee **rejected** the application of M/s Akkrediteret Vejer & Inspection Aarhus A/S Vejebro Aarhus on the following grounds-

- (i) The applicant does not have any spectrometer
- (ii) The calibration certificates are unsigned
- (iii) The serial numbers are not embedded in the machines

9. Humber Inspection International Ltd., UK

The Committee **rejected** the application of M/s Humber Inspection International Ltd., UK on the following ground-

(i) Inspector Alert 35148 shown by the applicant is also shown by M/s Techsusho Kayaba Corp., Japan as possessed by them

(i) The details of spectrometer have not been given in AERB format

(ii) Zoro Tools Monitor M4 74981, 75051 & 74975, GS Geiger Group Gamma Scout 59441, 59983 & 59086, Barringer Manufacturing Sabre 2000 - 20285, Building Material Centre Redalert 100 – S0512 shown by the applicant are also shown by M/s Gurudev Overseas Ltd., Ludhiana as possessed by them

11. Baltic Control International Ltd., UK

The Committee **rejected** the application of M/s Baltic Control International Ltd., UK on the following grounds-

- (i) The applicant does not have any spectrometer
- (ii) The invoices are unsigned
- (iii) The serial numbers are not embedded in the machines

12. Pacific Trade Inspection Services P Ltd., Australia

The Committee rejected the application of M/s Pacific Trade Inspection Services P Ltd., Australia

on the following ground-

(i) Radcomm Mspec 200062, 200059 & 200065 shown by the applicant are also shown by M/s Techsusho Kayaba Corp., Japan as possessed by them; the last two machines have also been shown to be possessed by Al Khalidiah Metal Tr. Co. LLC, UAE

13. AVS Inspection LLC, UAE

The Committee **rejected** the application of M/s AVS Inspection LLC, UAE on the following grounds-

(i) The technical details have not been given

(ii) Radcomm Mspec 200154 shown by the applicant is also shown by M/s Neerakshan Engineers

& Surveyors, Chennai as possessed by them

(iii) Radcomm Mspec 200148 & 200149 shown by the applicant is also shown by M/s Techsusho

Kayaba Corp., Japan as possessed by them

14. Shackleton Freight & Services Pty. Ltd., SA

The Committee **rejected** the application of M/s Shackleton Freight & Services Pty. Ltd., SA on the following ground-

(i) The applicant does not have explosive detector

15. Ganapati Scientific Solution, Nepal

The Committee **rejected** the application of M/s Ganapati Scientific Solution, Nepal on the following grounds-

(i) The serial number of the spectrometer given by the applicant is not matching with the

photograph

(ii) The applicant does not have the minimum requirement of radioactivity detecting machines (1 surveymeter + 1 spectrometer or 2 spectrometers)

16. Rank Inspection Services Ltd., UK

The Committee **rejected** the application of M/s Rank Inspection Services Ltd., UK on the following ground-

(i) The minimum detectable range of the machines has not been given

(i) Radcomm RC2 3622 shown by the applicant are also shown by M/s A/S Baltic Control Ltd.,

Denmark as possessed by them

18. Ravi Energie Inc., USA

The Committee decided to **hold in abeyance** the application of M/s Ravi Energie Inc., USA till the investigation / procedure under FTDR Act against M/s Ravi Energie Pvt. Ltd., Baroda is completed, as the two companies belong to the same group of companies.

19. Ravi Energie Gulf FZC, UAE

The Committee decided to **hold in abeyance** the application of M/s Ravi Energie Gulf FZC till the investigation / procedure under FTDR Act against Ravi Energie Pvt. Ltd., Baroda is completed, as the two companies belong to the same group of companies.

20. Intertak India P Ltd., New Delhi

The Committee **rejected** the application of M/s Intertak India P Ltd., New Delhi on the following grounds-

- (i) The applicant does not have explosive detector
- (ii) The calibration certificates do not have any date

(i) The applicant has added new machines instead of giving details of machines initially shown in the application form / rectifying deficiencies of the machines earlier indicated

29. Salamex 1894 Pty. Ltd., SA

The Committee **rejected** the application of M/s Best Mulyankan Consultants Ltd., Mumbai on the following grounds-

- (i) The applicant does not have any spectrometer
- (ii) The applicant does not have explosive detector
- (iii) The calibration certificates / photographs of machines have not been given

30. Nippon Kaiji Kental Kyokai, Japan

The Committee **rejected** the application of M/s Nippon Kaiji Kental Kyokai, Japan on the following grounds-

- (i) The applicant does not have explosive detector
- (ii) The applicant does not have any spectrometer
- (iii) The calibration certificates and invoice of the machine has not been given

33. MN Trade Services Inc., USA

The Committee **rejected** the application of M/s MN Trade Services Inc., USA on the following grounds-

- (i) The applicant does not have any spectrometer
- (ii) The calibration certificates of one out of two machines has not been given; date not mentioned in the calibration certificate given
- (iii) The technical specifications of the machines have not been given
- (iv) The model number / serial number not shown in photograph

34. CLX Surveying & Evaluating Services LLC, UAE

The Committee **rejected** the application of M/s CLX Surveying & Evaluating Services LLC, UAE on the following grounds-

- (i) The calibration certificates of the machines have not been given
- (ii) The photographs of the machines have not been given
- (iii) The invoices of the machines have not been given

37. G.P. & Associates, Bengaluru

The Committee **rejected** the application of M/s G.P. & Associates, Bengaluru on the following grounds-

- (i) The applicant has not submitted the application fee
- (ii) The details of the machines have not been given

38. Techsusho Kayaba Corp., Japan

The Committee **rejected** the application of M/s Techsusho Kayaba Corp., Japan on the following grounds-

- (i) The applicant has same machines as also shown by M/s Cosmos Inspection & Analysis, Haryana; M/s Global Marine Inspection Unit, New Delhi; M/s Nectar Inspection Services LLC, UAE; M/s Humber Inspection International Ltd., UK; M/s Pacific Trade Inspection Services P Ltd., Australia; M/s AVS Inspection LLC, UAE; M/s Al Khalidiah Metal Tr. Co. LLC, UAE.
- 5. The Committee also reviewed its recommendation in the case of M/s Asia Inspection Agency Co. Ltd., Thailand on the basis of a complaint received. M/s Asia Inspection Agency Co. Ltd., Thailand was approved as PSIA vide P.N. No. 15 dated 31/5/2016. The Committee has recommended that only 2 machines, Radcomm 200125 & 200126 may be approved for the applicant, as these were the only machines found acceptable by the Committee as per the stipulated requirement, and approval granted to other machines as listed in P.N. No. 15 dated 31/5/2016 against M/s Asia Inspection Agency Co. Ltd., Thailand is withdrawn.
- 6. The Committee also considered the request of M/s Exim World Ltd., Canada and M/s WISE Services FZE, UAE for addition of new machines. The Committee decided that applications for new machines / areas will not be considered in this meeting as under consideration at this stage is only the cases of new applicants.
